

## MOEN LAKE CAMPGROUND

### 2014 RULES AND REGULATION

- Renters must be at least 21 years of age. Renters are responsible for all their guests and children during their stay with us. Campers and their visitors will not hold Moen Lake Campground responsible for any loss of personal property or any injuries. This includes any injury from use of sports equipment. The campground owners and employees reserve the right to interpret and enforce all the rules for the benefit and safety of all.
- All renters and day visitors must register in the office. All vehicles must display proper car tags. Any vehicle in the campground without the proper tags and registration with the office is subject to towing.
- Check in time is at 3:00 p.m. and check out time is at 11:00 a.m. for campsites and cabin rentals. Early check in fee is \$20.00 based on availability.
- We do not charge extra for sunshine and we do not give refunds if it rains. Our cancellation policy is as follows: Less than 14 days notice-no refund is given. More than 14 day notice a refund less \$25.00 cancellation fee will be refunded on campsites only. Cancellations of cabins, your down payment will not be refunded unless the vacancy is filled. If vacancy is filled you will receive your full down payment less \$25.00 cancellation fee.
- Quiet hours are from 11:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. After 11:00 p.m. your neighbors should not be able to hear your activities. Parents are responsible for the whereabouts, actions and safety of their children and may not leave them unsupervised. All children and teenagers under age 18 must be back at their campsite or with their parents by 10:00 p.m.
- Any person (adult or child) found stealing, damaging any property, dealing or using drugs, causing injury to another person etc. will be evicted from the campground immediately and prosecuted for any damages accordingly. Anyone found violating the restrooms or showers in any way will be evicted. If you observe any person abusing this rule please inform the management. There is no smoking in restrooms, showers, recreational hall or any common area buildings.
- One camping unit and one tent (not a pop-up camper) are allowed per site. Two vehicles are allowed per site. Campsites and campers should be maintained in an orderly, neat and sanitary manner, No garbage or trash outside of your camping unit.
- The speed limit in the campground is 5 MPH. Any and all vehicles must adhere to this speed limit. If your car is leaving a dust trail it is traveling too fast. Trucks over 3 tons are not permitted on the campground roads and must be parked in the parking lot behind the Recreational Hall. Please watch for children while driving in the campground.
- Golf carts, ATV's mopeds and motorized scooters must be registered with the office. Proof of insurance is required. You must be 16 or older and have a valid driver's license to operate a golf cart, ATV, moped or motorized scooter in the campground. These types of vehicles are subject to the 5 MPH rule. Operation of vehicles is limited to the developed roads in the campground. Rough joy riding of any sport vehicles on park roads is prohibited. Quiet hours vehicle usage is limited to destination driving and no "cruising or parading" around the campground is allowed from 11:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.
- We do provide honey wagon service during your stay. The cost is \$10.00 and will need to be scheduled and paid for ahead of time at the office. There is a dump station available free of charge and is available for all campers staying with us. There is no dumping of wastewater (including dishwater) on the ground. Please use the dump station or honey wagon service. Do not dump this water in the bathrooms.
- DO NOT throw cigarette butts or any garbage on the ground. Please dispose of in the proper containers.
- Garbage must be removed from your site when you leave. All garbage and recyclables must be separated accordingly and must be in clear bags and placed at the end of your campsite daily for pick up. Aluminum cans are to be kept separate from other recyclables. Plastic, tin cans and glass are to be bagged together. All other garbage can be bagged together. Disposal of appliances, mattresses, metal, furniture, lawn chairs, bikes or any large items is prohibited. Any individual found disposing of such

contents will be charged \$200.00 per item. If you are unsure of what can be disposed of please ask the management.

- Parties, excessive noise, drunkenness, foul language, immoral and illegal conduct will not be tolerated. Please be considerate of your neighbors and the children surrounding you. Management reserves the right to contact the police for excessive violations. Please keep all radios, stereos, TV's etc. at a reasonable sound level. If you are not in your camping area, your audio equipment should be turned off. All music must be off by 11:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.
- You may not bring your own firewood into the campground. We sell firewood at the office for your camping experience. No trees or limbs may be cut down (dead or alive). If there are fallen branches in your immediate area please feel free to collect them and utilize them as firewood for free. No gathering of wood from our woods is permitted.
- There is absolutely no digging, burial of wire or hoses or moving of fire rings. Campers will be charged for any damages caused by the digging or burial of anything on their campsite.
- Campfires may only be made inside the provided fire pits. No BONFIRES are allowed. Fires may not be any higher than 12 inches above the outside area of the fire pit. Fires must be extinguished upon your departure or as you retire for the night. PUT YOUR FIRE OUT COMPLETELY. No burning of garbage in fire pits.
- If you have a pet please inform management right away as you will be required to adhere to our pet policy which will be provided to you on a separate rules and regulations form.
- No fireworks are allowed in the campground. There is also no nailing of anything to any tree with out the expressed approval of management. Anyone found violating this will be charged for a new tree.
